DIG DEEPER THIS WEEK:

Take time to read Acts 2:1-11

Verses 1-4 "When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them."

ASK YOURSELF THIS WEEK:

- > What might God be saying through this passage to you? To your corps/centre?
- > When was the last time you felt the Spirit moving in your life?
- > Do you live in a Spirit-filled way that people around you ask, 'What does this mean?'?

COVER IT IN PRAYER THIS WEEK:

Pray for a refilling of the Holy Spirit and an expectation for the Spirit to move powerfully. Pray that those around you would be drawn to what's different in your life.

Pray for a sense of expectancy for yourself and your corps/centre for this next season.
