DIG DEEPER THIS WEEK:

Take time to read Titus 3:1-11

Verses 4-7 "But when the kindness and love of God our Saviour appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Saviour, so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life."

ASK YOURSELF THIS WEEK:

- > What might God be saying through this passage to you? To your corps/centre?
- > Do you need to be reminded/encouraged again that you are saved not by what you do?
- > What does it mean for you that you are Christ's co-heir, having the hope of eternal life?

COVER IT IN PRAYER THIS WEEK:

Pray again for the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit in your life and setting. Pray that the hope of eternal life would be evident in your life to those around you. Pray that people in your community would rediscover the truth and power of the Cross.
